Marcus Fluch win first race of 2015 season

The inauguration of the third season of the Volkswagen Golf Cup at Oschersleben track did not disappoint the expectations of fans and drivers of 25 cup Golfs prepared by Volkswagen Racing Polska gave a racing demonstration at the highest level. On each of the fourteen laps lot had happened and the fate of victory hung in the balance until the last meters. Ultimately Marcus Fluch was the fastest, just over a second over Michał Gadomski. Fastest in qualifying, Jefrey Kruger, completed the top 3.

Pole sitter for both races of Volskwagen Golf Cup didn't enjoy the lead for the long, as early as the first corner was headed by Marcus Fluch. Swede tried to impose the pace and move away from rivals, but it was easier said than done, because Gadomski, who also managed to jump in front of Kruger, gave chase and all the time he was a threat to the leader.

On the back of the lot was happening, because Dylan Pereira was hoping for the lowest step of the podium and stayed close to the rider in third place Kruger. Clash between Cup veterans grew louder and two laps before the finish to come into contact in the second turn, after which driver from South Africa went into full of the slide, but in the end he managed to regain control, and even keep you in front of Pereira.

At the very end safety car after an accident of Simon Larsson, made an unexpected turn in action. The biggest fail at restart went to driver from Luxembourger, when Pereira lost position to Andre Gies and had to settle on fifth place, which gave podium to Kruger.

Sixth place went to Simo Muhonen, who finished in front of Manuel Fahnauer and Gosia Rdest, which can be regarded as a hero of the race. Female driver from Żyrardów went through the field after start from twelfth place and coped well with a fierce fight for positions in the final ten, which eventually fell to Sebastian Arriola and Pascal Hoffman.

Michał Gadomski: - It was a tough race, at the beginning I approached Jeffrey Kruger, he made a mistake and I quickly managed to overtake. In the next phase of the race have spent more push-to-pass and my advantage has diminished, but he made another mistake and had contact with Pereira, so I was able to maintain its position to the finish.

Gosia Rdest: - Very nice result to start the season, and I'm happy. I started from the 12th position, so gaining four more is positive. Throughout the race I fought with Piotr

Parys, but I managed to get out of this fight victorious. My push-to-pass strategy worked very well, because at the end of the race still could once use it. For the second race I start from the same position and I am very positive attitude. Is likely to be dry, I feel very comfortable already on the track, so I hope for a good result.

Alexandr Artemyev: - It was a very good race, but I had a wrong tire pressure, which cost me a lot of time. Unfortunately, I was unable to regain the lost position. We have a little time before the second race, so will make sure that the correct setting of our Golf GTI. For the afternoon I start the race from the 16th position, so my goal is to drive to the finish line in the top ten

Manuel Fahnauer: - I finished the first race in sixth position. The start was crucial, because there could be much to gain or lose. During the race I had big problems with understeer and I was not able to advance to the front. We still do not know what the weather will be during the second race. If you continue to be dry, will make sure you do not make the same mistakes. My goal is to drive on the podium.
